## This funding will be used to

- Ensure that every student will either achieve National Minimum Standard (NMS) in literacy and numeracy for their year level or have an evidence-based learning plan in place to address their specific learning needs.
- Ensure that 100% of students not requiring intensive teaching will achieve at least one band above the NMS in Reading, Writing and Numeracy (Band 3 in Year 3 and Band 5 in Year 5).

## Our initiatives include

- Planning, assessment alignment and moderation across small schools' cluster.
- Identified students to receive intensive one-on-one support to improve reading and or numeracy throughout the year.
- All students from Prep to Year 2 to receive regular one-on-one intensive reading and sight word practice.
- Providing differentiated groupings at least three times per week (with use of teacher aides).

## Our school will improve student outcomes by

Actions	Costs
Providing intensive one-on-one support with literacy and numeracy.	\$7160
Provide intensive one on one reading and sight word practice by teacher aides for all Prep to Year 2 students and for all students that are identified in the upper grades.	\$6000
Teacher release to access planning, assessment alignment and moderation across small schools' cluster - enabling teachers' access to a professional learning community with peers.	\$4000
